

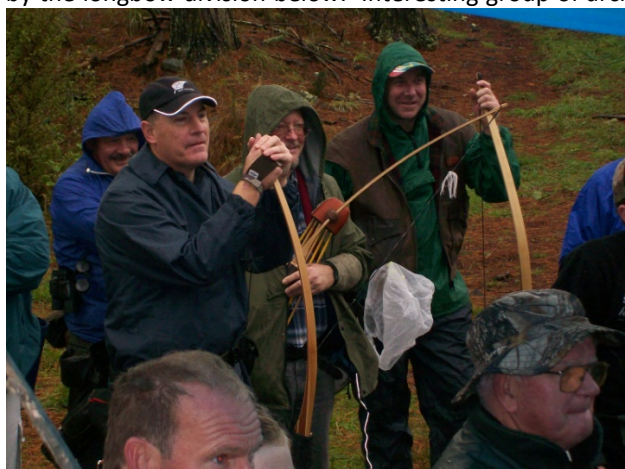


Ultimate Challenge IBO Series 2010

Round 1 Franklin Report

At the end of round 1 the competition was already well on the way for top scores in most divisions. Trevor was the top scorer in round 1 with an impressive 196 and Jason Loane and Tony Moxsom scoring 187. The Recurve Unaided division was the largest of the divisions and there is some real competition brewing in this division. It was also great to welcome archers from Dargaville, Rodney, Whangarei, Massey, Whitford, Franklin, Thames, Te Aroha (new archers to the event – a big welcome) and of course our most travelled archer – Dave Rix from Foxton Beach all enjoying the day regardless of weather.

It is good to see the ladies divisions growing again and good to see an archer, Emily Kai Fong, who last year shot as a Young Female to go into the senior division this year and take out 1st place followed closely behind by Carlene Cram in second place.

Travelling from Auckland

- come off the motorway Te Irirangi Drive

- Follow this road through to Ormiston Rd – has a set of lights with Petrol station across the intersection – shopping centre directly beside you.

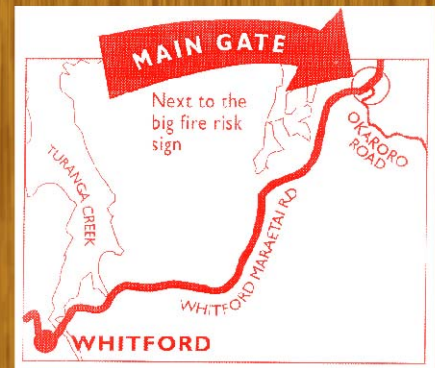
